Huddle for 100 is an NFL initiative that launched at the 2019 NFL Draft and will continue through Super Bowl LIV in Miami. The NFL is celebrating its 100th season and through this NFL100 initiative we will all strive to make meaningful investments in the communities of our fans and inspire the entire NFL family to give back. The goal is to get <u>one million people</u> to give <u>one hundred minutes</u> of their time to community service, totaling <u>100 million volunteer minutes</u>.

All 32 NFL clubs will host huddles throughout the year and the NFL will drive a season-long competition between clubs. Monthly \$5,000 grants to be used for a community initative will be awarded to top-ranking clubs based on their volunteer minutes. 


